### **FOOD PANTRIES**

#### **FARMINGTON:**

The Care & Share Food Closet is a food bank located at 508 Fairbanks Rd. Farmington. The Care & Share Food Closet provides a multiple-day food supply once a month for those in need in the Greater Farmington area, and partners with other local food pantries.
